Remove all garden furniture, storage or other items from the decking so that the entire surface to be treated is clear.

Use a stiff broom to give your decking a good sweep. This will get rid of any dirt or loose bits of wood and general debris from the decking.

Check the surface of the deck for any loose boards or raised screws. And use a screwdriver to secure them more tightly.

Let's get planted


There are some estate recommendations that if adhered to, will stop unnecessary costs and increased services charges.

Balcony garden watering is different than watering in a garden

- Hanging baskets create issues to upkeep of the balcony when watering the flooring rots makes unsafe and water dripping down onto your neighbours below is not good
- Using trays with all plants will address that problem
- Using stands will also help control water issues and also use your space wisely









For those herb gardeners keep it neat and tidy
