
## Updated letter box safety


It's just a suggestion .....DIY




By using a longer brush it covers the complete view into the letterbox from outside See following how to do it guide ...DIY



Order from screw fix it's the 75mm brush size you want ... You can make at least 7 maybe 8 letterbox covers: Because it's actually to use on doors the metal length it's far to long however the brush is the perfect drop.







## The steps to take

- You need to cut the metal and the brush to the required length .... measure the opening of the letter box from inside to be sure correct size before marking and cutting.
- Please note have pliers handy to squeeze the end of the metal when cutting the brush.
- Apply glue to the inside edge face of the letterbox frame surround and apply glue to the front of the metal with brush that you've cut, let dry for a few moments and then push together.
- Hold firm so your sure it's stuck fast (maybe wear a rubber so not to get glue on your fingers see glue box for details.
- Then apply glue to the top of the flat metal strip and glue to the roof of the letter box pushing firm against the other section so it keeps a snug fit :
