Refuse Collection Schedule:

- General refuse every Tuesday
- Mixed Recycling every Friday
- Food waste every Friday

To ensure that all our refuse is collected on time please follow these simple steps: -

- Place the correct refuse in the correct bin.
- 2) All household/ general rubbish is to be bagged properly and placed in the bin, do not leave on the floor or anywhere else.
- 3) All mixed recycling, Empty and rinse all containers. Squash plastic bottles. Remove film lids from plastic pots, tubs and trays flatten large cardboard boxes and place in the recycling only bin. No Black Bags.
- 4) Food waste, place all cooked and uncooked food in the bin, **No Liquids Oils or Packaging.**
- 5) If the bin you usually use is full, please find another on the estate that has room to take your waste and report the bin chamber to treehouse@brenleypark.co.uk
- 6) Please keep any bin lids and doors closed properly, to deter rats and other pests.

Fly Tipping

Leaving large or bulky items, such as mattresses, cupboards, carpets, sofa's etc. in or near the bin stores is not allowed. If you need to dispose of large or bulky items you have the following options.
