Every item of waste disposed of correctly has a positive impact on the environment and the service charges that you pay. The team would like to reduce the amount residents pay towards removing items dumped in and around the bin stores. (Fly tipping).

If you rent out your apartment, please ensure this information is made available to your existing and future tenants as part of their property information pack.

If you notice fly tipping at Brenley Park, please provide as much information as you can, such as car registration number, flat number etc to treehouse@brenleypark.co.uk

Merton Council has a very strict policy and can result in personal fines starting at £150 and can possibly lead to a criminal conviction for serious offences.

How to dispose of your items that cannot be placed in the communal waste bins.

Items of Furniture: example carpet, TV, chair, table, mattress, fridge freezer or smaller items such as rug, plant, lamp, bedding are not allowed in the general refuse and will not be taken with our regular Merton Council waste collection.

These items require the resident to dispose of them using one of the options below.

- If in good condition consider offering the item via the community WhatsApp group or an app such as freecycle/eBay.
- Book a visit, to Merton Recycling & Reuse Centre 63-69 Amenity Way, off Garth Road, Morden SM4 4AX
- Contact Merton Council on 0208 274 4901 or using this <u>link</u> to arrange for your item to be collected. Cost of up to 3 items £35.30, 4-6 items £57.85.

<u>CARE</u>: These items must only be placed outside on the morning of the agreed collection day.
